I am responding to your request, pursuant to the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the *Act*), for access to information, our Information and Privacy File No.: 2019-1379.

You have requested to know if the NRP were asked to do any investigations regarding racist accusations and death threats or hate crimes in relation to the Short Hills Park deer hunt and if so, the number of people investigated and the follow-up conclusions. You are seeking information from November 2019 to the present.

Please be advised that the police received one complaint from the public regarding the social media posts.

The police reviewed the posts and deemed them not to be criminal in nature. No investigation was commenced.
